## Travelling by Car

The Rose Bowl is situated just off Junction 7 of the M27. From Junction 7 please follow signs to The Rose Bowl or see map below.



## Vehicle Parking

If you have a parking pass please ensure that it is displayed at all times and it is in place before arriving at The Rose Bowl. Members parking is subject to availability and is available on a first come first served basis. There are no designated spaces.

**THE MEMBERS SEASON PARKING PASS IS VALID FOR ALL LV COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP, FRIENDS PROVIDENT TROPHY, NATWEST PRO40 AND TWENTY20 (EXCLUDING TWENTY20 FINALS DAY) MATCHES. IT IS NOT VALID FOR CONCERTS.**

Public pay on the day parking is likely to be available at all LV County Championship, Friends Provident Trophy and NatWest Pro40 matches at £7 per vehicle (7 seats or less). Parking for these matches can not be booked in advance. For all Twenty20 matches (excluding Finals Day when separate arrangements will apply) you are strongly advised to book your parking in advance at £7 per vehicle (7 seats or less) by calling our Ticket Office on 0870 243 0291 or by visiting [www.rosebowlplc.com](http://www.rosebowlplc.com) Pay on the day parking may be available at Twenty20 matches at £10 per vehicle (7 seats or less). Please check availability before travelling.

Car Parks will open an hour before the scheduled gate opening time and will remain open until 60 minutes after the close or abandonment of play. Please ensure your vehicle is removed before that time.

During rush hour periods exit from The Rose Bowl may be delayed. Please be patient and consider delaying your journey home in order to avoid congestion.

Southampton Parkway Station - trains from London Waterloo to Bournemouth and Weymouth.

Hedge End Station - trains from Portsmouth, Winchester and Basingstoke.
